v. Funding Resources

Members who apply and host relevant activity will bear its expenses.

Chinese MOST will provide financial support to the following operation and activities of the Network:

- 1. Provide funding to the Secretariat for its daily operation;
- 2. Sponsor one China-ASEAN STI Policy Training Workshop (it can be hosted in China or organized jointly with ASEAN countries)
- **3.** Sponsor China-ASEAN STI Policy Research Center and other members to do **joint research**, according to the requirements of ASEAN countries
- **4**. Sponsor **5-10 STI policy researchers** from ASEAN countries annually to Chinese STI policy research institutes for **6-12 month visit and exchange**.
